In this connection, it is stated that CBSE has launched SARAS portal during this academic session i.e. 2021-22 for seeking extension of affiliation of Govt. Schools for the session 2021-22. The following mandatory documents are required to be uploaded on the SARAS portal:



| 4 | Copies of recognition certificate under RTE Act, 2009, and it is renewal if applicable | All Govt. Schools are recognized by Education Department, Chandigarh Administration, Chandigarh |
| 5 | Copy of valid building safety certificate as per the national building code | The said certificate is still to be issued by the Competent Authority. There are certain documents required to be attached for obtaining the said certificates: 1. Land Certificate to be issued by the Estate Officer, UT, Chandigarh. 2. Building safety certificate to be issued by the Engineering Department, UT, Chandigarh |
| 6 | Copy of valid fire safety certificate issued by the Competent Authority | The fire safety certificate is still to be issued by the Competent Authority. There are certain documents required to be attached such as: 1. No demand certificate in respect of property tax |

Further to add that minimum 02 months time is required to obtain documents such as land certificate as well as fire certificate as the said certificates are to be issued by the various authorities as it is a lengthy process. As and when the said documents are issued by the competent authority the same will be supplied along with the requisite fee.

It is, therefore, requested that affiliation during the current session i.e. 2021-22 in favour of all Govt. High Schools/Govt. Model High Schools/Govt. Sr. Sec. Schools/Govt. Model Sr. Sec. Schools running under the control of Education Department, Chandigarh Administration, Chandigarh may be accorded without any loss to the studies of the students. It is also certified that Education Department, Chandigarh Administration, Chandigarh has no objection to the affiliation of all Govt. Schools with CBSE. On receipt of the said documents from the concerned department, the same will be supplied along with the prescribed fee.
